




Tools Needed

PREPARATION FOR INSTALLATION


The screen doors are attached to your vehicle via integrated magnets along the perimeter of the screen. To ensure a proper mount, it is recommended to clean the entire door perimeter jam area with a microfiber towel and warm water. Note: If there is excessive debris within the doorjamb parameter, take time and care to properly clear making sure not to damage any portion of the OE weather seal on the vehicle.



Removing the door screens

1. To remove the door screens, start at the top center and with light force, pull to remove the magnets one at a time from the vehicle's doorjamb.

2. Use caution when removing making sure that no portion of the door screen assembly gets caught or snagged on any of the vehicle components.

3. While making your way down the doorjamb begin carefully folding the door screens for secure storage in the included storage bag.



SET-UP & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

CLEANING

Clean with cold water and a soft bristle brush. Do not use soaps and detergents. Do not expose to petrol, diesel, oils or chemicals of any nature.

STORING

Correct storage is vital for the longevity of your Ford Transit Door Insect Screens. If on occasion the screen is required to be stowed wet, it is essential it is unpacked and dried as soon as possible. Rot, mildew damage and incorrect storage is not covered under warranty.
