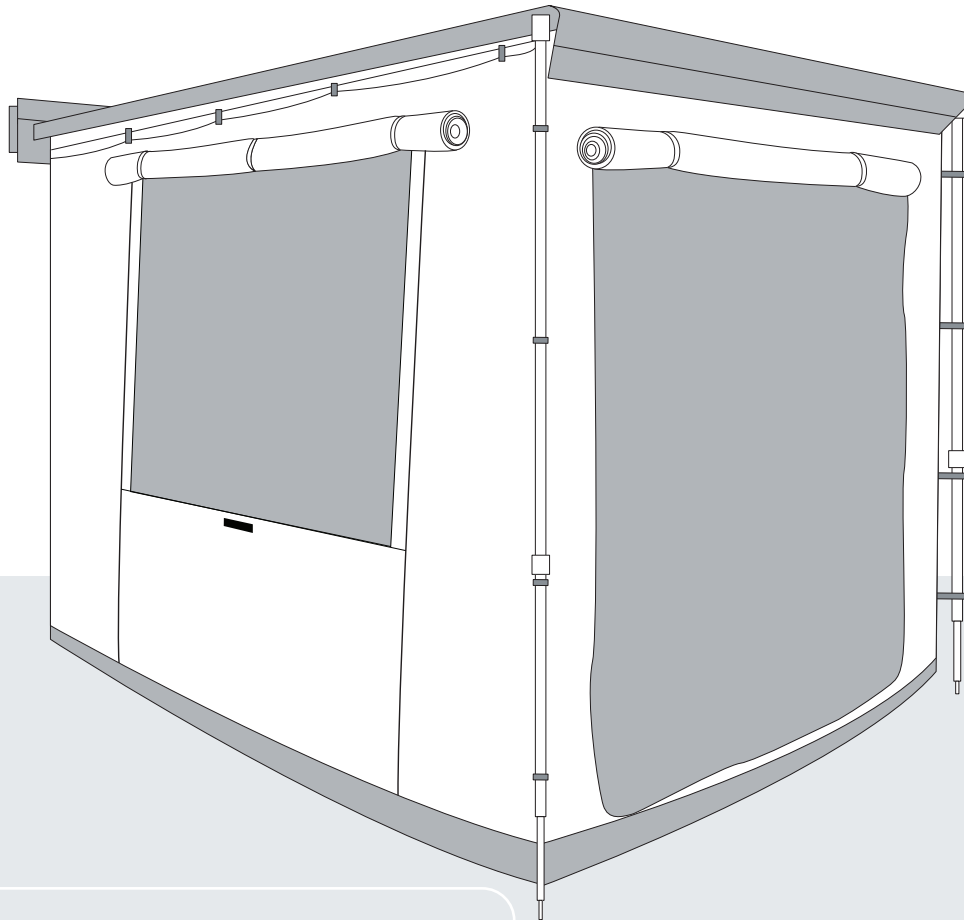

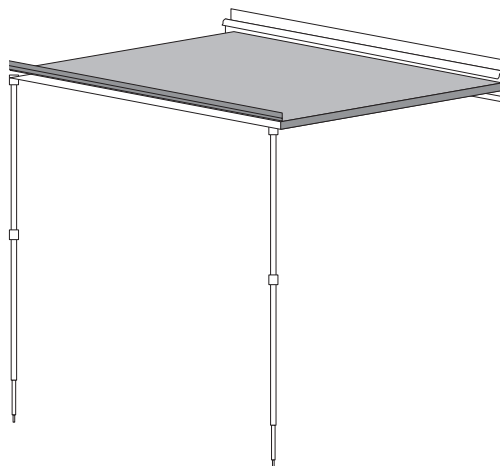

SET UP INSTRUCTIONS

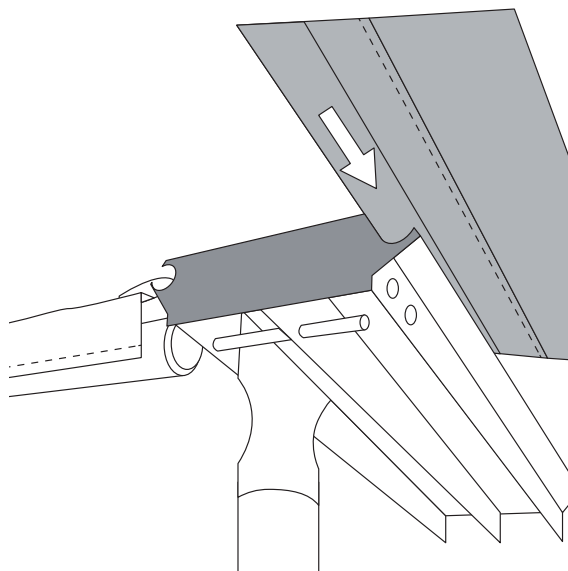

The Tent Annex can be quickly and easily attached to your erected awning.



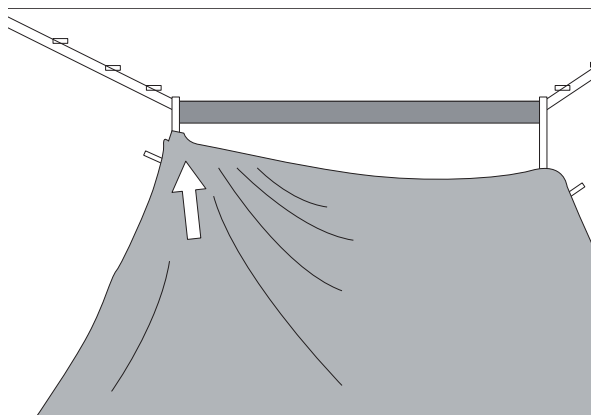
Slide the rope cord with zip attachment flange along the front awning rope track.

NOTE: Zipper will be facing towards inside of awning.

Slide main body of the Annex into the lower rope track on the main awning extrusion.

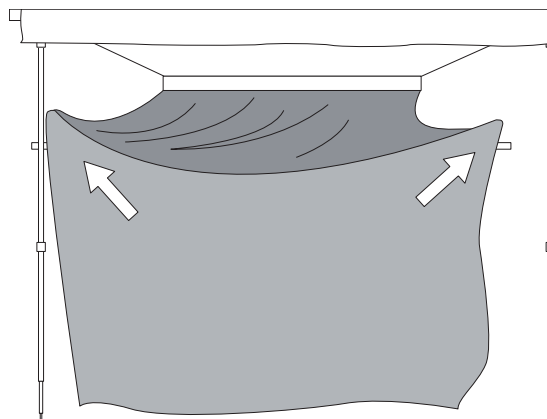

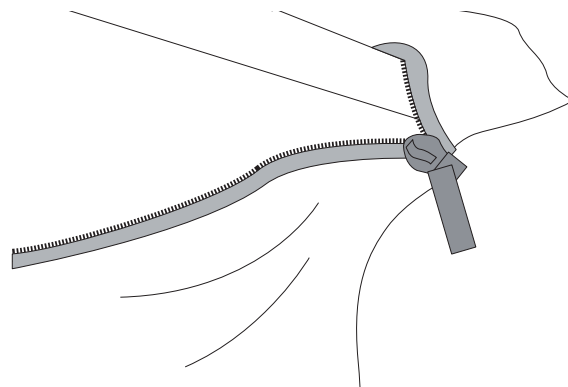
Pull Annex Forward, towards the front awning rope track.

NOTE: Fix velcro loops along top bars making your way toward the front of the awning.



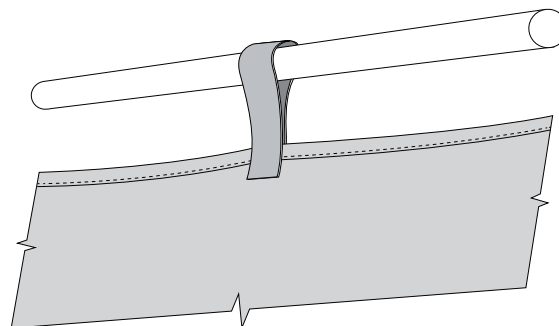

Zip the two sections together. It may be necessary to release the tension on the awning rafter arms to get the zip started.

Once the Tent Annex has been installed, the awning rafter arms can be re-tensioned. Then fix Velcro loops to the awning rafter arms.



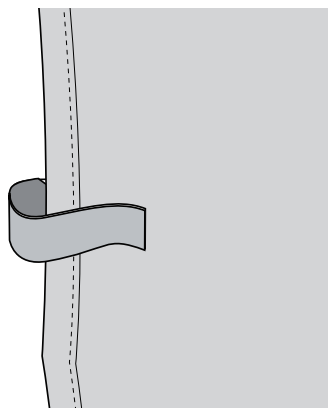
Awning Annex Room

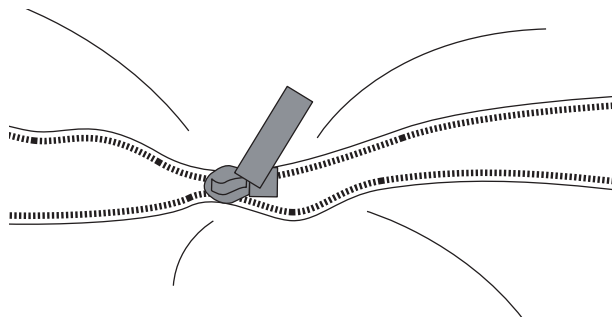

Fix Velcro loops to the awning legs.



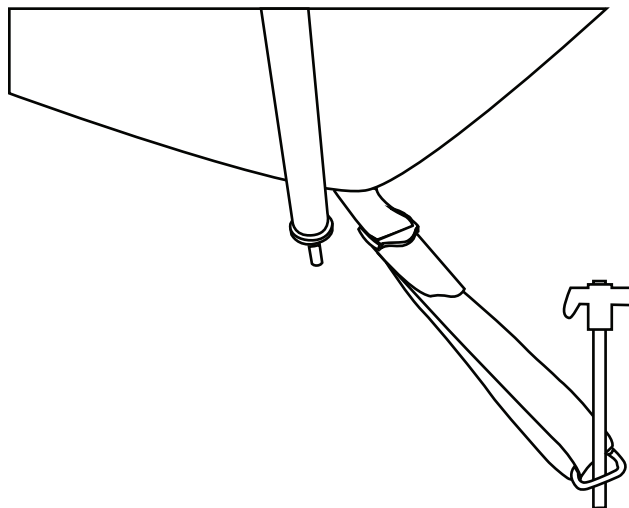

Optional: The PVC floor can be zipped off of the awning annex room for easy cleaning.

It is recommended to use the supplied stakes to secure the floor of the annex room.

MAY 2024

CLEANING

Clean with cold fresh clean water and a soft brush.

DO NOT USE SOAPS OR DETERGENTS ON THE TENT ANNEX.
DO NOT EXPOSE TO PETROLS, OILS OR HARSH CHEMICALS.

STORING

Correct storage is vital. If the Annex Room was dismantled when wet, then it must be dried as soon as possible.

If annex room is stored wet, open to air out and completely dry as soon as possible.

SUITABILITY

The Annex Room has been designed for general camping use in normal conditions.



WARNINGS

- DO NOT ATTEMPT TO SETUP TENT ANNEX IN WINDY CONDITIONS
- ALL STORM GUY ROPES MUST BE ATTACHED AND PEGGED TO THE GROUND AT ALL TIMES
- GUY ROPES ARE TRIP HAZARDS IN THE DAY AND NIGHT
- KEEP ALL FLAME AND HEAT SOURCES AWAY FROM THE TENT ANNEX MATERIALS
- UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCE SHOULD ANY NAKED FLAME SOURCES OR HEATING DEVICES BE USED UNDER OR NEAR THE TENT ANNEX
- KEEP CAMP FIRES WELL AWAY FROM TENT ANNEX
- KEEP A LOOK OUT FOR ANY AIRBORNE BURING EMBERS THAT MAY COME INTO CONTACT WITH THE TENT ANNEX
- DO NOT SMOKE WITHIN THE TENT ANNEX
- DO NOT OPERATE ANY DEVICE WHICH BURNS FUEL INSIDE OF THE TENT ANNEX
- KEEP EXIT CLEAR
